Regular Town Business:

1. Consideration to approve purchase orders, bills, prepaid warrant, transfers and budget amendments as submitted by the Director of Finance.
2. Resolution to approve the proposed 2013 Webster Town Budget.
3. Resolution to authorize the Supervisor to sign the 2013 All Seasons County/Town Agreement.
4. Resolution to refer to the Planning Board a sketch plan from Hegedorn Associates, to allow semi-detached use(s) in the proposed Coastal Village subdivision.
5. Resolution to authorize the bond for Barbara J. Ottenschot, Receiver of Taxes, to be approved as to the amount of (\$250,000.00), form sufficiency of surety thereof, the cost of said bond being a charge upon the Town of Webster, and that this bond is filed in the office of the Clerk of the Town and will be examined by the County of Monroe attorney.
6. Resolution to abandon a portion of the conservation easement on 524 Granger Circle.

7. Resolution to abandon a portion of the conservation easement on 528 Granger Circle.
8. Resolution to approve a change in the Town of Webster health and dental payroll deduction procedures, authorizing the elimination of pre-payment for both and changing the deduction for employee contributions to health insurance from monthly to bi-monthly.
9. Resolution to approve standard work days for elected and appointed officials in compliance with the New York State and Local Employees' Retirement System.
10. Resolution to approve transfer of an abandoned cemetery, known as the Robb Cemetery, to the Village of Webster after a New York State Home Rule is enacted.
11. Resolution to declare the following as surplus for transfer from the Sewer Department to the Cable Television Department: (1) 2003 Ford Cargo Van, for a cost of \$2,000.00.
12. Resolution to declare the following as surplus for transfer from the Sewer Department to the Highway Department: (1) 2006 Ford Cargo Van, for a cost of \$4,000.00.
13. Resolution to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Blue Collar Contract for a period of four years (2013-2016).
14. Resolution to authorize the issuance of \$185,000.00 in serial bonds of the Town to finance the cost of acquiring and constructing the improvements constituting the Klem Road Water District Extension #5.
15. Resolution to advertise for bids for the Klem Road Water District Extension #5 (Drumm Road) Project.
